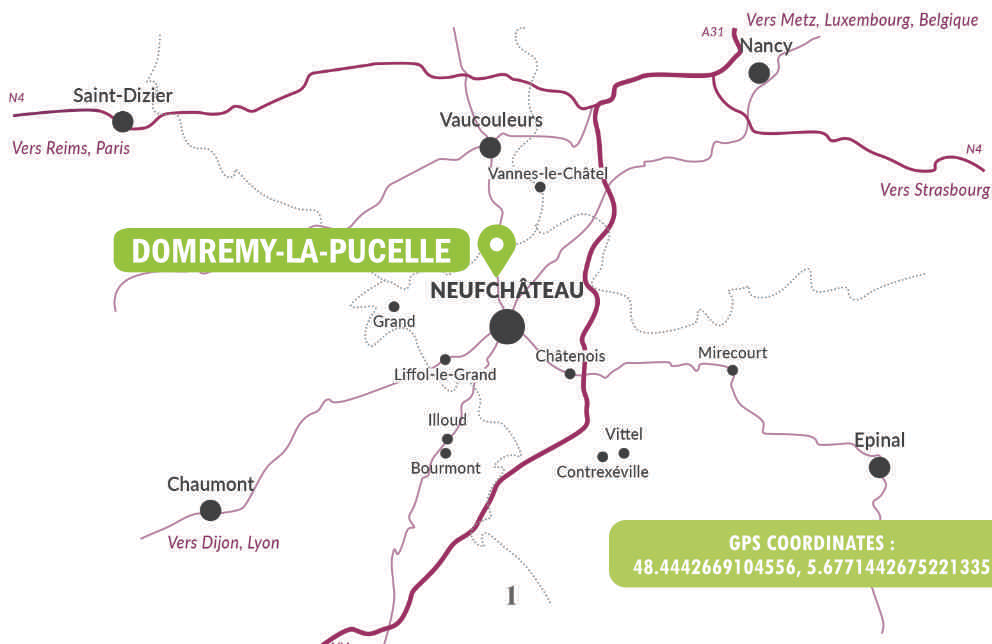

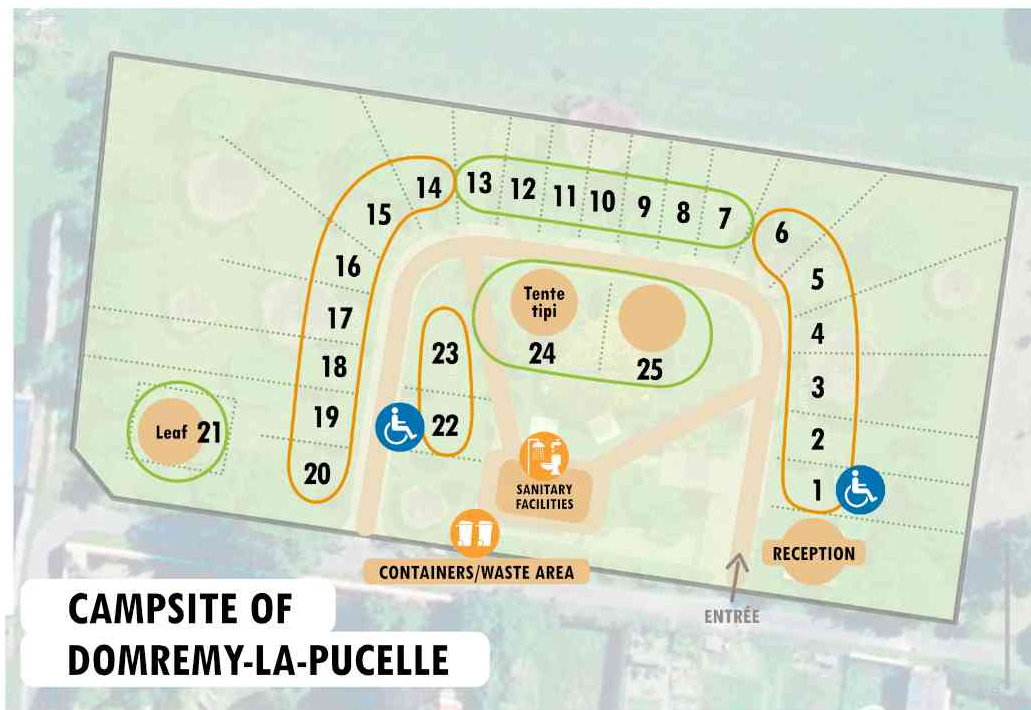

To access the campsite during its closing hours, you must have the code that activates the gate. This code will be given to you when you arrive at the campsite and/or when you confirm your booking.

— OUR SHOP —

To enhance your stay, we offer a range of local products that are 100% Vosges and 100% Lorraine.

— OUR GROCERY SHOP —

In addition to the restaurants in the immediate vicinity of the campsite, we offer a mini grocery shop with basic products as well as dishes prepared by the chef at the LA MARMITE restaurant in Greux (450 metres away) for €11.

Every evening (except Sundays), **you can order bread and pastries** from the staff at reception. Your order can be collected from 8.15am the following day.

Whether you're here for a single night or several, the Domremy campsite offers 2 types of light accommodation.

this bungalow has 1 double bed, a table, two chairs, a shelving unit and a bedside table.

It is also equipped with electric sockets, a convector heater and, of course, LED lighting both inside and on the terrace.

Important: bed linen not provided (sleeping bags can be rented).

Tipi tent

This tent, very popular with itinerants, includes 2 camp beds (sleeping bags can be rented), lighting and electricity. It is accessible by a ladder, so it is not suitable for people with reduced mobility.

Underneath the tent is a table and benches for a convivial meal. The tent is also close to the campsite's electric griddle for preparing vegetables, fish and meat.

– PITCHES –

The campsite has 23 'bare' pitches, including 15 for vans/ caravans/camping-cars and 8 for tents. These pitches range in size from 87 m² to 127 m².

Motorhomes and caravans can plug in to the communal terminals provided (4 sockets available per terminal).

For information:
there is no access to water, nor private sanitary facilities in the leaf or in the tipi tent.

The gate at the entrance to the campsite is open when staff are on duty, i.e. from 8 am to 10 am and from 3 pm to 7 pm, seven days a week.

At all other times, this gate is closed and will only be opened for those who already have a pitch or a confirmed booking. They will have been given the code.

— A CAMPSITE — THAT RESPECTS ITS ENVIRONMENT

Because we love nature and want to preserve it, our campsite is committed to more responsible tourism.

Every day, we take concrete action to reduce our environmental impact while offering you a comfortable and authentic stay. We are also in tune with the location and environment of our campsite in the heart of the village of Domremy-la-Pucelle.

The campsite has just undergone renovation work that has enabled us to plant new trees, shrubs and flowers to enhance the natural and biodiversity aspects.

The areas are laid to lawn.

Our environmental initiatives :

- **Green energy:** LED lighting, limiting energy consumption
- **Timer and motion sensor** for lighting in and around the toilet block
- **Solar lamps** to mark the pathway inside the campsite
- **Public lighting** that dims in the evening.
- **Water management:** flow reducers in sanitary facilities
- **Waste reduction:** selective sorting, elimination of single-use plastics
- **Eco-responsible furniture:** the furniture has been recycled to give it a second life or custom-made by the HOLYWOOD BOIS PARTAGE workshop based in Neufchâteau (10km from Domremy-la-Pucelle).
- **Preservation of biodiversity:** management of green spaces using local species, planting of berry bushes and flowers, as well as a self-service area with aromatic plants.
- **Use of Ecolabel-certified cleaning products.**
- **Encouraging soft mobility:** the campsite is located on the EuroVelo 19 - La Meuse à Vélo itinerary, has a secure bicycle room (code) and offers reduced rates (-10%) on pitches for tents as well as on 2 types of accommodation (tipi tent and leaf).

THE RIGHT GESTURES



- **Sort your rubbish in the bins provided** (household waste, recycling, glass)- Instructions are displayed to help you sort your rubbish, which is often specific to each department, country, etc.
- **Save water:** water is a precious resource, so don't let it run unnecessarily when showering or for domestic use.

Rules of procedure

I. REGISTRATION FORMALITIES AND PAYMENT OF FEES

On arrival, campers must go to reception to complete admission formalities (see opening hours).

Fees are payable on arrival and are collected each evening.

Fees are payable either :

- In cash
- Credit card
- Holiday vouchers

Cheques not accepted. No refunds will be made (except in certain cases).

II. DRESS/RESPECT

- Campers must refrain from any behaviour that might undermine mutual respect between campers and their neighbours.

- Decent dress is required
- Silence is required from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

III. HYGIENE/HEALTH

- Water points, washing-up facilities, showers and toilets are available to campers.

- These facilities must be kept as clean as possible.

- Rubbish and waste must be deposited in the containers provided. These containers allow glass, paper and plastic bottles to be recycled.

- Campers are forbidden to dump waste water on the site. In particular, they must not dispose of used washing-up water at the foot of trees.

IV. ANIMALS (CATS AND DOGS)

Pets are accepted under the following conditions:

- They must be kept on a lead when on the move.
- They must not disturb the peace and quiet of campers day or night.

V. TREES

It is forbidden to cut branches or hammer nails into trees..

VI. FIRES

Fires are prohibited. Preferably use electric barbecues/planchas or the communal 'Cooxy' electric griddle.

VII. VEHICLES


Car drivers, motorcyclists and caravanners are asked to drive through the campsite at reduced speed, following the posted signs.

Parking on the tracks is prohibited.

Cycling in the campsite off the tracks is not permitted.

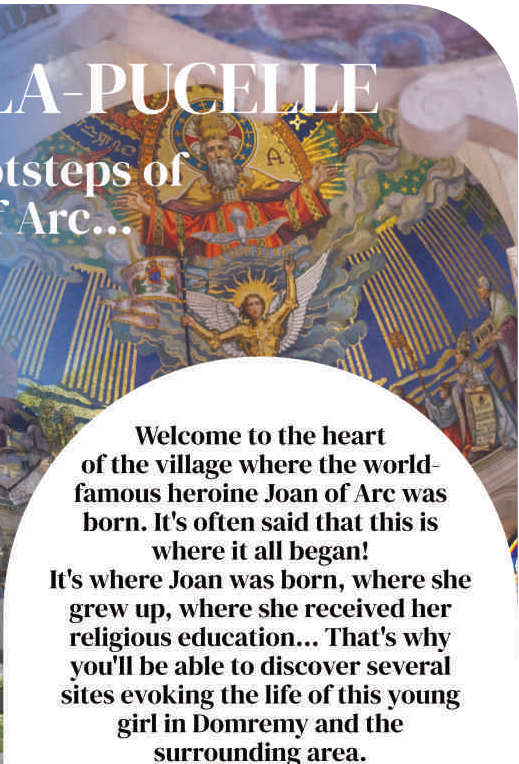
Your campsite is also your Tourist Office.

You can sign up for guided tours, workshops, accompanied outings and more. We also have booklets of walking and cycling games for children aged 4 and over.

DOMREMY-LA-PUCELLE

In the footsteps of
Joan of Arc...



Welcome to the heart of the village where the world-famous heroine Joan of Arc was born. It's often said that this is where it all began! It's where Joan was born, where she grew up, where she received her religious education... That's why you'll be able to discover several sites evoking the life of this young girl in Domremy and the surrounding area.

– TO DISCOVER –

- **The house where she was born:** this is consistent with the evidence left by Jehanne, confirming that it was indeed her father's house. It has undergone many changes since then.
- **The 'Faces of Jehanne' interpretation centre** takes visitors back to the heart of the Middle Ages, with 4 themes to discover: 'In the intimacy of Jeanne', 'Jeanne, daughter of the frontier', 'Jeanne, woman of arms' and 'From character to myth'.
- **The Basilica of Sainte-Jeanne d'Arc** overlooks the Meuse valley. It is the monument that symbolises national recognition of Jehanne d'Arc. **You are free to visit every day from 9am to 7pm.**, or sign up for one of our guided tours (dates available from reception).
- **The church of Saint-Remy** is in the immediate vicinity of the birthplace. You can visit it freely throughout the year and also take one of our guided tours (dates available from reception).

– GREUX –

Situated in the commune of Greux, in the Vosges department, three kilometres north of the birthplace of Jehanne d'Arc, the chapel and hermitage of Bermont have watched over the Meuse valley for over a thousand years. Jehanne liked to go there on pilgrimage, on Saturdays and often during the week, to offer candles and flowers to Notre Dame, to meditate and to pray. You can take one of our guided tours (dates available from reception).



– MAXEY-SUR-MEUSE –



The Beauregard plateau at Maxey-sur-Meuse is the most northerly of the department's limestone grasslands. The landscape quality of the site, its openness and its size make it an exceptional site. Seen from the plain, the Beauregard promontory stands out in the landscape without revealing the limestone grassland it shelters. The contrast between the wide alluvial plain where the Meuse slowly meanders and the wooded hillsides accentuates the appeal of the site. Signs in the village centre guide visitors to a small car park and the start of the signposted trail.

The Beauregard chapel is home to a very old and beautiful stone piéta dating from the 14th or 15th century. The choir windows are adorned with pretty stained glass windows dedicated to the Virgin Mary: to the left of the Notre-Dame de Lourdes altar and to the right of the Notre-Dame de la Salette altar. Tiles cover both facades and bear witness to the passage of time. There are traces of soldiers from the First World War, young lovers and couples who have added their children's names over the years.



GRAND LA GALLO-ROMAINE

The Grand amphitheatre is one of the largest monuments of the Roman Empire.

Its 180-metre corridor is longer than that of the Nîmes arena! As for the mosaic (232 m²), it is considered to be one of the greatest works of its kind. This village has yet to reveal all its secrets, but it's sure to enchant you!



ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITE OF GRAND

Opening hours: April, May, June: 9.30am to 1pm and 2pm to 6pm (closed on Tuesdays) / July and August: The mosaic and the Amphitheatre 10am to 1pm and 2pm to 6.30pm, daily.

— LE FORT AUX ENIGMES — MONT-LÈS-NEUFCHÂTEAU

With family or friends... discover this fortification, dating from the 19th century, transformed into an ideal place for families. Ludo, the mascot, will be on hand to suggest a host of activities, pastimes and games. You'll travel through the fort's many galleries and rooms, where a variety of challenges await young and old alike.

And if you're an escape game fan, the Fort's team will be organising 2 special evenings each summer.

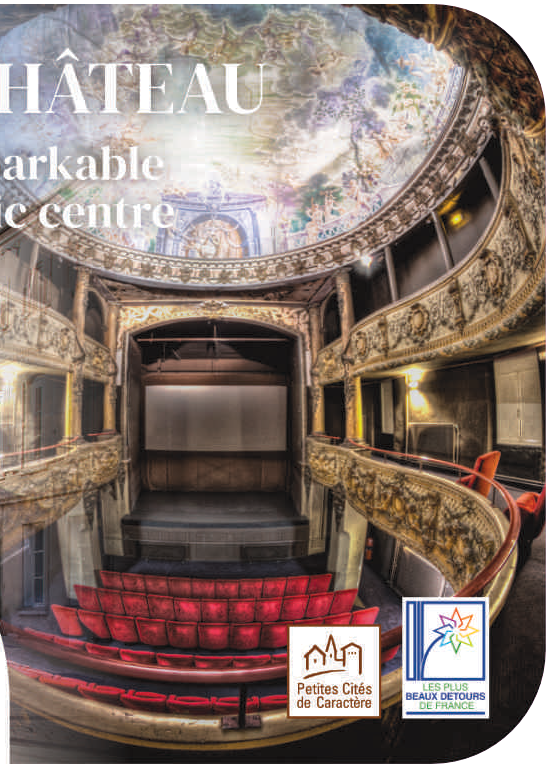

NEUFCHÂTEAU

A remarkable
historic centre

Listed as one of
the 100 Most Beautiful Detours
in France and holder of the Petite
Cité de Caractère label, the town
of Neufchâteau is an invitation to
discover. Many treasures are hidden
behind doors to which the Tourist
Office team holds the keys.



So, all year round, whether on a scheduled tour, a flash visit or a VIP tour, don't miss out on the city's must-sees: Place Jeanne d'Arc, the church of Saint-Nicolas, the church of Saint-Christophe, the former court and Italian-style theatre 'Le Scala', nestled in a former convent, as well as private mansions including the Hôtel de

Houdreville, which houses a sumptuous Renaissance staircase.

For a fun way to explore the town with children aged 4 and over, 3 booklets are available from Neufchâteau Tourist Office.

– CHÂTENOIS –

THE BEGINNING OF THE DUKES OF LORRAINE

Châtenois has a prestigious past: it was the first capital of the Duchy of Lorraine when, in 1048, the Emperor gave Gérard d'Alsace the hereditary title of Duke of Lorraine. Châtenois is also nicknamed 'Little Lorraine Brittany' because of its high concentration of crosses and calvaries. Last but not least, the town has a rich gastronomic tradition, with its famous Pâté Lorrain.

Visits to the Priory are organised on a regular basis - find the dates on the tourism-ouest-vosges.fr website.



– FREBÉCOURT –

Overlooking the Meuse, this 12th-century castle is a jewel of the Vosges region and is listed as a Historic Monument. A former fortress turned country house, it boasts an 80-hectare park designed by Choulot and Duchêne. **Its new owners now open it up for events such as the 'Soirée Blanche' or the 'Soirées de Mille Feux!'**



– WESTERN VOSGES –

LAND OF EXPERTISE IN THE ART OF WOODEN FURNITURE

The western Vosges is a land of expertise, as demonstrated by Liffol-le-Grand and Neufchâteau, where some factories have been awarded the GI Siège de Liffol. These towns have specialised in woodworking, particularly for chairs.

The Henryot & Cie factory regularly opens its doors for tours of its workshops.

– NATURE –

An exceptional natural environment awaits you in the western Vosges: limestone lawns and hillsides, exceptional flora and fauna with a southern flair, including many types of orchid and butterfly. You'll be given all the information you need at reception to help you make the most of your visit. Ask for the guide!



– EUROVELO 19 – LA MEUSE À VÉLO

An itinerary well worth the diversions! The Meuse à Vélo is an international cyclo-tourism route that stretches over 1000 km from the source of the Meuse, on the Langres plateau, to its mouth at Rotterdam, where it flows into the North Sea. Don't hesitate to ask us for a brochure outlining the various stages.



– RANDONNÉES –

On foot or by bike, you'll discover magnificent landscapes and historic sites along the way. To help you along, walking maps starting from the campsite or within a short radius are available from the campsite reception. There are over 350 km of waymarked footpaths in the western Vosges.

As a family, try the Randoland® walks, accessible to children aged 4 and over. Each walk involves solving an investigation by answering 8 riddles (3 levels: 4-6 years, 7-9 years and 10+ years)!

Starting from the campsite, you can explore the village of Domremy-la-Pucelle on foot or cycle a section of the Meuse à Vélo either towards Neufchâteau or Maxey-sur-Meuse.
